IBCI Conference 2012

The Irish Building Control Institute is pleased to present the IBCI Building Control Conference, 2012. The Conference will afford an opportunity for those involved in Building Control throughout Ireland to network with their colleagues and receive an update on current developments.

The Conference will be held over two days in the **Radisson Blu Hotel, Athlone, Co Westmeath**. Lunch and refreshments will be provided on both days, with the Conference Dinner on the Wednesday evening. A **Trade Exhibition** will also be held in conjunction with the Conference.

Day 1 will include an update on the Building Control legislation and procedures and on latest developments on Part B Fire Safety. This will be followed by a paper on sustainability issues in buildings

After lunch we have devoted most of the session to Disabled Access Certification. We will first see the DAC application Guide issued by the LGMSB followed by the perspective of the private sector finishing with a discussion/questions on this whole subject. Finally we have hopefully a lively soapbox if anyone wants to raise any relevant issues.

Day 2 commences with paper on waste water treatment of domestic one off houses followed by a paper on the new BS9991, Fire Safety in residential buildings. After coffee we have a paper on the new Building For Everyone-Universal Design, and we finish the final session with a paper on fire safety in Heritage Buildings
